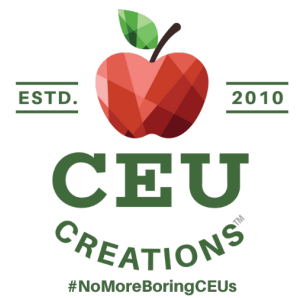

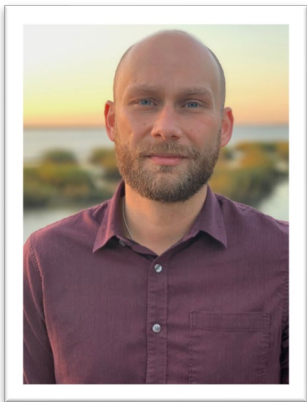

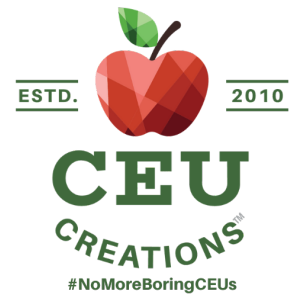

This training will dive into many facets of telemental health, including intake and assessment, informed consent with sample forms, different types of delivery methods, HIPAA rules including HIPAA-compliant platforms and rules around electronic communication, issues that arise with termination of services, policy changes and updates on COVID policies, risk management, social media ethics, and other ethical considerations.
